Target Areas:	10 villages across 3 communes in Samaky Meanchey District of Kampong Chhnang Province
Beneficiaries:	At least 1500 families of small rice farmers in the target area will be trained to build good rice fields following the Sre Laar model to become highly sustainable, productive and diversified fields. These families will also participate in rice mill and savings cooperatives.
Project Goal:	Develop the model of resilient farms to effectively use their available resource compatible with climate change adaptation and biodiversity.
Specific Objectives:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) Improving rice production through the adaption of climate-smart agriculture techniques; ii) Strengthen the adaptive capacity of community members through the reduction of hazard relating to water accessibility and management in farming practices, and to use water effectively and efficiently; iii) Increase knowledge of CC lens in commune councilors, farmer leaders and other local stakeholders for integration into the Commune Development Plans (CIPs) and annual Commune Investment Program (CDP).
Anticipated Results and Project	Result1: 100 Key Farmers (KFs) will be selected by the project based on the potential of farm development in 10 villages and 30

Activities:

experienced KFs will be selected to receive additional training as Farmer Promoters (FPs), based on their capacity not only in farm management but also to train other farmers at their and neighboring villages.

Result2: At least 1500 families of **small rice farmers in the target area** will be trained to build good rice fields following the Sre Laar model to become highly sustainable, productive and diversified fields. At least 10 private ponds will be dug and/or rehabilitated into small reservoirs, including community pond or small canals, alongside training of management committees to oversee the use of these resources. 10,000 trees will be planted near farms, ponds and reservoirs to mitigate erosion. 10 village pounds; one per village.

- Develop 20 on-farm experimentation and learning sites
- Organizing the monthly training for target farmers by FPs
- Organizing the exchange visits

Result3: 100 Farmer Leaders (FLs) will be selected according to their potential to hold leadership roles. 10 villages will be selected to receive capacity building trainings aimed at increasing cooperation with local key stakeholders especially the commune councilors. These villages will develop a strategic plan for integrating the climate change lens the annual Commune Investment Program (CIP) and Commune Development Plan (CDP).
