Beneficiaries:	Up to 74,200 individuals improved their knowledge on financial management both in family and group for investing in agriculture and other income generation activities.
Project Goal:	To conduct a series of training sessions on Financial Literacy to farmer-members of the Improved Group Revolving Fund (IGRFs) as well as the group committee members to enable them to better manage their own budget and the group fund (conditional capital grants) for investing in agriculture and other income generation activities
Specific Objectives:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Project beneficiaries are capacitated to make better financial decisions both in the household as well as for their financial investments in agriculture or other income generating activities. 2) Groups of project beneficiaries will be better able to optimize the use of the conditional capital grants that they will receive under the PADEE project though loans. 3) Members of the IGRF will understand that by the end of the project their group is expected to be promoted as a financial cooperative/credit union.

	4) Project beneficiaries will have opened, and learned to operate, a savings account in an MFI.
